

SEI STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP TO STRUCTURES CONGRESS

SEI student members: Expand your opportunities while learning, networking, and having fun with colleagues.

The scholarship provides complimentary Structures Congress student registration and travel assistance for student members (undergraduate or graduate) to attend and actively participate in Structures Congress. The scholarship is brought to you by the SEI Student Initiatives Committee and the [SEI Futures Fund](#).

Travel assistance includes economy airfare with 14-day advance purchase within the US, and \$135 per night for up to four nights participation at [Structures Congress](#). Note this is not full cost reimbursement. Travel funding is reimbursable to recipients following the conference with completion of the scholarship requirements below.

ELIGIBILITY

Student applicant must be:

- Full time SEI student member (membership is free)- undergraduate or graduate student enrolled in a Civil Engineering or similar program
- First-time attendee at Structures Congress

APPLICATIONS ARE EVALUATED ON FOUR PRIMARY AREAS:

- short-term career goals
- long-term career goals
- research and/or internships
- volunteer work and/or professional organization participation
- GPA or stated need of support are used by committee when scores are close

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Participate in a brief welcome orientation (conference call prior to Structures Congress and in person at conference).
- Attend two committee meetings (one of which should be the Student Initiatives Committee). Note that all committee meetings will take place on Wednesday.
- Attend the Meet the Leaders event Thursday.
- Participate in the full conference (Wednesday committee meetings thru Saturday closing).

- Submit a one-page narrative providing feedback on the experience.

Apply by December 5. Selected recipients will be notified by January 5.
